To the Members of the California State Assembly:

I am signing Assembly Bill 223, which would require the Department of Transportation to install business logo informational signs along Interstate 80 within, or at exits leading to, the City of Truckee until January 1, 2021.

Last session, I signed a similar measure that, in addition to requiring the department to post similar signs along State Route 65 within the City of Lincoln, mandated a report back to the Legislature by January 1, 2020, regarding the benefits of the sign program and whether the program should be expanded to other urban areas.

I am directing the department to expedite this report. It would be appropriate to wait until this report is complete before enacting any subsequent signage postings by statute.
