To the Members of the California State Assembly:

I am returning Assembly Bill 446 without my signature.

It would authorize a school district, county office of education or State Board of Education to donate surplus property or obsolete instructional materials to individuals in adjoining states.

This bill is unnecessary. Current law already authorizes the donation of these obsolete materials to public agencies in other states. A school district or library in Nevada that receives materials from a California school district can certainly then donate materials to individuals in Nevada.
